

NEWS OF ROAD & OTHER INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS IN UPPER ARLINGTON

Fishinger Road Phase I Reconstruction (Mountview Road to Five-Point Intersection)

The contractor for Fishinger Road Phase I has been awarded to Strawser Paving a contractor who has completed several construction projects for the City of Upper Arlington. Crews will begin to bring equipment and materials onsite for the start of the project beginning the week of October 10, 2022.

The work will begin with the installation of setting up the Maintenance of Traffic and installing temporary pavement on the north side of Fishinger Road from Mountview Road to Reed Road.

Residents that live on Fishinger Road from Mountview Road to Reed Road will have interrupted access to their driveways periodically construction due to the installation of the temporary pavement. We will notify you of full driveway closures in advance.

Your refuse, recycling and yard waste collection services will be provided as usual. Please make sure to have your items for disposal at the curb on the evening before your normal day of collection.

Please notify us if you have either an electric dog fence or irrigation system located behind the curb. If you have a special circumstance such as the delivery of medical supplies or if any member of your family needs any special assistance, please let us know so that we can accommodate your needs while this construction projects is in progress.

The City understands that you will be inconvenienced during the project, and we will do everything possible minimize the disruption. Your patience and understanding while we complete this project will be greatly appreciated.
